We believe that on the great points of the gospel the evidence is so clear that when you examine it there is no question where you will come out, under most circumstances. But when you come to the secondary points we believe that every human being has (2 1/2) and there are places where you may find the truth where I am in error about it. Don't follow me, follow the Scriptures. Learn to take what God says as the final word and determine to follow that Word wherever it takes you. We believe that that is the sort of leadership that God will bless, the leadership that is based solidly and exclusively upon the Word of God. Now we have tried at Faith ever since its foundation to put a very great amount of stress upon evangelistic effort. We have Street Meetings through the fall every Friday night, we encourage our students to speak at the Mission, to take part in personal work, to do everything they can to spread the Word of God, we believe that a Christian should be a soul-winner, he should be one who is spreading the message of the Word of God, we believe that God expects every believer to be an evangelist in the true sense, an evangelist who follows the Scripture without compromising, has no alliance with the forces of darkness, but presents the truth and stands upon it. We have always put great stress on this and we have put a great stress upon the missionary vision. We have many missionaries speak to us during the year, we believe that the Christian who is not interested in the work of God in the uttermost parts of the earth is not going to accomplish much in the work of God in the part where he is. God wants us to be interested in His work in every part of the world. We think however that there has been a disproportionate attitude in the past and I think that it is one (4 1/4) why modernism has made such strides in the past fifty years. About forty years ago there was a widespread attitude fostered by the earnest preaching of some very ardent, earnest missionary advocates, but an attitude which seemed to get this attitude into people's minds: if you are really out and out for the Lord, you are
