A couple of days after I was back to Princeton I ran on to Dr. Stevenson, the president, and Dr. Stevenson said to me, "Oh," he said, "I think on the whole we came out pretty well in that assembly." He said, "All they did was to postpone Machen's appointment to be acted on later, the nextyear." He said, "There were there were there who wanted to the said of the said of Machen's the management of Machen's the money having come from liquor."

This was one of the stories that was circulated in the attack on Machen. Machen said to me, "I would hate to think that a cent of the money that I have had come from the liquor interests in any way." The Modernests Modernists would stop at mag nothing, it seemed, in order to hurt Dr. Machen.

At the end of school that year I stayed for a time in Princeton and Dr. Wilson gave me some special instruction in Old Testament textual criticism.
