not hir Bible Evangelism; we hired him.

In preparation for the coming of the men from the State to examine us for permanent right to give degrees it was necessary to get the books into such shape that they showed the quasi endowment regularly. A great deal of time and effot was expended on this, and it was found necessary to consider more than the \$6,000 from a year from those five years as quasi endowment in order to figure out a way of having it show—the books show that this had been paid. Dr. Murray—xi reluctantly—I had nothing to do with it the discussion over this. Mr. Clark told me about it. Eventually Dr. Murray—agreed to counting—some money that was understood to be his salary enough, the \$6,000 a year and more, enough to make up \$40,000, considered as having been quasi endowment to the seminary. WE received a letter from Bible Evangalism saying that they could no longer provide any quasi endowment after the end of the 1982-83 fiscal year, or was it 1981-82? [This of course is x a very simply off the top of my head, giving a general memorandum to myself, and therefore not necessarily trying to be precise at every point.]

The matter was never brought up ik the Board in what I would consider a reasonable way. Two years ago I asked to see Dr. Murray and he made an appointment to come to my home. He came and I asked him, "Exactly what do you want Dr. Murray? I would like to do whatever I can to help." He refused to discuss the matter with me. He mi said, "It is entirely mp a matter between the Board of Bible Evangelism and the Finance Committee of the seminary." He said, "It's up to the Finance Committee to make a suggestion; then it is up to the BE Board to either accept or reject the suggestion, and it must be handled in this way."

The Finance Committee, about this time, or possibly earlier, said they thought that he was owed \$20,000 in mi accordance with the terms of the make suggestion he had made earlier. This of course was entirely unsatisfactory to him and toward the end of 1982 he wrote a letter maxingkhananingkhananingkhananingk saying that Bible Evangelism had heavy obligations and that the entire sum due him must be paid immediately, before the end of that year.
