Kantzer kas said he thought it was good that the man left the organization.

After this meeting Thismeeting was sort of toward the end of the conference in the big auditorium there all the 300 or so people who were attending and the the meeting had been together. Other meetings had been held in various meeting rooms in the place, but at this meeting they were all divided into little groups in different parts of the room, these groups of maybe 15 or 20 each. This was to be followed by a general meeting. At this general meeting the reports were to be brought in from the different committees, little smaller groups, each of which had a part of the general statement to consider. He, standingon the platform, he said, "Dr. MacRae, could you writer act as secretary of the group?" We-1, the thought of writing down all the many suggestions made by all these different committees and keeping them in order, and everything; I ; just didn't see how I could do it, so I almost on the spur of the minute, I answered, XXXXXXXX SME something like, "I can hardly read my own writing; I forget exactly," but anyway they then got somebody else. Then they called on one of the groups for a report and they theyought there should be a lot of changes here and there, and they didn't think that the committee should (I believe this was the third day) they didn't think the committee should then make any final decredecision but that copies of the suggested statement should be sent to all the oeople present and should be considered over the next six we weeks and eventually
