for I know there were some there who did not stay for the fourth day, but I do not know whether he was or not, at least he does not seem to be very prominent in its actual direction anymore.

It is my impression that he is now trying to plan a new organization with a different purpose altogether. Whether this is an institution that will -accomplish a great deal or be only a flash in the pan, I due cannot predict. He has got some good men's approval to say they will join with him in it. My impression is that he has a tendency to planto accomplish more than is possible and that it might be wiser to take a smaller objective than he tends to. I have written him to that effect. I also, however, told him that I would be willing to be one of his new organization if Dr.James Kennedy and Dr. Km Krabbendam, who,he told me, were in it, continue to be in it.

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
