And these are evidences of proper in his last on the accuracy in the Bible. Now there is no book in the Bible that is more doubted and questioned than the book of Daniel. There are other books which tell about wonderful appearances of God but to someone lost in the hills of Judea somewhere. Somewhere you might say on the outskirts of civilization and it is easy for someone to say, Oh well ~~it's just~~ that's something way off in some little country. but here in Daniel you have the headquarters of the greatest Emperor today. Right ~~in~~ in Babel it shows you have seen Nebuchadnezzar and you have Belshazzar the great rulers that are in that city and you ~~have~~ are told how God intervened and you have there in behalf of Daniel and behalf of his right there in the palace of those.

Well this book concealed at that time. A critic you unanimously agreed that the book of Daniel was not written at the time Daniel but was written 400 years later in the Maccabean period. And about 168 B. C. someone could see you the exact month which came out 168, others say 166 but they will all agree that and the reason is that that is the time the Jews were fighting against the Syrian oppressor. And the very light of intellect was ^{at stake} ~~at stake~~ and the very life of the Israelites was at stake. And they say at that time somebody made up this book of Daniel in order to encourage and in order to cause them to fight more valiantly and that is what is agreed upon. I know a great
