Now of course what we are interested in isn't to try to get something (10 1/2) with us and we can be happy about it, and we are against something that seems to advance the Jews, but we are interested in what does the Bible teach, and to me it is an outstanding evidence on this matter of how these people said to Jesus in Acts 1:6, after 40 days, this is speaking of the things pertaining to the Kingdom of God. They said to him, Lord wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom. (11) but after 40 days, He presented to them the spiritual kingdom, how (11 1/4). If you can't get through your heads in 40 days, but his answer was, not you are completely wrong, the kingdom will not be restored to Israel. It was, it is not for you to know the times nor the seasons, which the Father has put in His own power, but you shall reign in power (11 1/2). That seems to me is a pretty definite (11 1/2) that the restoring of the kingdom (11 3/4). Well, that was a question (12) objection to earthly, b.

d. Objection regarding alledged restoration of sacrifices. Listen to what Hamilton says about that, page 137 in his book.
