The Bible clearly teaches that Jesus Christ is coming back to set up His kingdom upon this earth, it clearly teaches there is going to be a time of external peace and safety in His present reign upon this earth. It clearly teaches that. And the question of whether all the people on this earth will then have glorified bodies or whether there will be some who will not, have it, is one which is determined by examination of the ~~Bib~~ Bible. And try to find out what the Bible teaches, not to say those who hold this, view generally (9) and therefore (9). Maybe they are wrong in saying that, but the essentials (9) are based upon clear teachings of Scripture and cannot be brushed aside (9). But this is an argument (9). And of course the question of it is an exegetical thing. (9 1/4) Berkhof refers to Revelation 21. It is interesting that Zahn one of the greatest scholars of the last century is even recognized by Barth who made great respect to Zahn, and Harnack quotes Zahn's work as one of the most - as something which it is hard to find anything to compare with. And Zahn was a thorough going pre-millennialist. A very earnest loyal conservative man and Zahn in his commentary on Revelation ~~he~~ strongly takes the pre-millennial view as to what Revelation clearly teaches, but when it comes to 21, he says 21 is describing the situation in the Millennium, which has been described in its general progress in chapter 20. That's what Zahn says. And personally, Zahn's argument convinced me but when it ~~did~~, about 12 years ago, I got together 2 other men at that time who were much interested in this, and told them what I believed and they were both quite shocked, and both strongly differed with Zahn and me on this point. They may be right. But at least it is not an open and shut matter that Revelation 21 follows Revelation 20, and if (10 1/2) what seems to ~~be~~ us to be best, but what does the Bible say?
