Calvin s always said, I will take this truth and take this proof and take this proof, and then as I relate these together I will draw a conclusion from it, I will not take this inference from the Scripture which is not specifically stated, in the Scripture, and draw stand on it. and say this is God's truth, you must understand it. I will draw the inference, then I will come to the Scripture and see if I find the inferences specifically taught, and if I do I will stand on it, but If I don't I will say merely this is my inference.
