the Midianites, that the Lord sent a prophet unto the children of Israel, which said unto them, Thus said the Lord God of Israel, I brought you up from Egypt and brought you forth out of the house of bondage. And I delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of all that oppressed you, and drave them out from before you, and gave you their land; and I said unto you, I am the Lord your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell; but ye have not obeyed my voice." That's all it says about this prophet. That's the only use of the word in the book of Judges. There are many prophets in Judges which are called by other names. But this is the only use of this word, and this prophet, this is all that we are told in the verse that I've just read, and what prediction did this prophet make that I've just been reading about? Mr. Rao? Mr. Dunzweiler? (He didn't make any prediction.) Ensor Exactly. He made no prediction, but he is called specifically a prophet. You might think of it as an implied prediction. He said they disobeyed God, but there certainly is no actual prediction. He said, I've brought you from Egypt and you have not obeyed my voice. And that's all he said. This is another instance fitting in with our definition. The # prophet is the spokesman for God. He came and gave a message which God gave to them. That's what the prophet does. So it exactly fits with the definition. It does not include any prediction in this case, but it is specifically called prophet. (Student).
