of these particular theories definite contradict or disprove the Genesis?" WXXXX For this we have to see exactly what does Genesis say about the formation of the universe? We have briefly noticed how the stages in the development of this particularly earth would fit in w very well with the present scientific theories ideas as to how the earth assumed its present/condition.
