And every page in the telephone book ends in an even number, ~~xxxx~~ will have a lot of numbers that are even numbers. I am sure that it would be the case with any ^{would} page of the book. Now, if I were to say ~~that~~ ... the reason ... all the odd numbers were put together in one book, and all the even numbers were in another book, and though they have some way been combined ~~together~~ here ~~by~~ by a redactor.
