individual. The Queen of the South shall rise up in the judgment with the men of thes and behold a greater than Solomon is here. He compares himself with one generation ---who was important in the O.T. and so sets His seal of approval on the factual statements of A greater than Solomon is here, well, if Solomon is just a myth, or legend, what did He mean by that? I think one of the strongest statements of all was made by our Lord Jesus Christ after His resurrection in Luke 24. Thexxwe There were some men who told Christ on the road to Emmaus they couldn't understand what had happened. The one whom they thought was the redeemer had gone and that was the end of Him. He said , Oh Fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken. You, if you are to be a true believer should believe all that the prophets have written. If you asked them what the book of Amos was written for, what do we have in the book of Zachariah, why is Habbakuk in the Bible? They wouldn't know anything about it. Yet they would think of themselves as followers of Christ. And maybe they are being used in a great way, but don't you think they would be used in a far greater way if they knew of the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ? Fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have told you. You can't believe it af you don't know it. I think that we can safely say that if we can prove that the O.T. (omitted from 4th to 5) What does this verse say here, that all scriptures is given faxxinspiration of God. From a child thou hast known the Holy Scriptures, - had he known the Gospels? had he known the book of Revelation? Timothy was brought up in a pious Jewish home and Timothy knew the O.T. and Paul says that he rejoices that from a child he has known the holy scriptures, which he says are able to make you wise unto Salvation. Then he goes on talking about the O.T. and he says All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for --- now all scripture, he is taking inspiration as a basis for something and when something is so certain that it can be taken for a basis for something else [omitted from 6章 to 7章]
