T he person who looks like an old kk hobo all the time, and yet has some good truth that affects some people, and really accomplishes something for the Lord, I have far more regard for, than the person dude who makes a fetish of cleanliness. But the person who does not give a considerable amount of attention to his xxxxx appearance is going to find his influence tremendously cut down, and his opportunity, especially in these days, his opportunity of extending the influence of his ideas. Reasonable Reasonable trust in humanity, and reasonable prudence - some people are so distrustful or 3536y everybody that they just can't trust anybody for anything. They've god to do everything themselves. They've got to watch at every single step of the way, and they don't accomplish. And then you find others who are just so trustful that they get c heated all the time. We have to guess (?) get (?) a reasonable balance on these things. There are so many of these areas I think it's good for us to note some of them and decide that we will seek for proper balance in them.
