an answer to these questions is to get a communication from someone who has gone through the experience; a revelation, a communication.

The only way we can tell MMMM anything about the beginning of this world is to get a communication, none of us was there. Scientists now tell us that probably there might have been an atomic explosion, with everything starting in one tiny point; and they say that within the space of half an hour all the elements that we have, all the chemical elements, may have been formed in half an hour; and since that time, they've been spreading out and forming new forms and new combinations ever since, but they were all formed in half an hour. Now that is a theory based on the fact that astronomy seems to show that the universe is shooting out in all directions at a rapid rate. But one philosopher to whom I said, "Here, then, is an evidence that seems to show that there was an original creation," said, "How do you know that that proves there was a creation?" He said, "Maybe there MAM is instead like an accordian: now it's going out, but formerly it came in! Maybe it's been going out and in like this for ever." Well, that just shows how difficult it is to tell by even scientific study what was, a million years ago; or what will be, a million years from now. You can make all kinds of theories, and you can't prove them. If we're going to MM know anything about the meaning of life, about the MINIMANIMA ultimate destiny, about its beginning, there's only one way to do it - to get a revelation from the One wholl made it, from the One who planned it, from the One who is directing it, from the One who is controlling it, from the One who knows where He is going to lead it.

We have believed for WM two thousand years, now, thousands of Christians have believed, that this Book constitutes such a revelation, that this book is a revelation which the Creator of the universe gave us, giving us information which we need to know. You see, it is as simple as that "God spoke". Well, now, that's the simple phase of it.
