unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people. and how the cheif priests and our rulers delivered him to be condumned to death and have crucified him. But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel, and beside all this, today is the third day since these things were done. Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre and when they found not his body they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels which said that he was alive. And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre and found it even so as the women had said but him they saw not. Then he said unto them,"and this is the interesting thing what he said to them. Did he say to them you walk with me for nearly three years, we discussed all sorts of things together. I explained all this to you. I told you how I was It is clearly going to die. I told lyou what it means and we know he did. told # that he did. I told you all this. Now why are syou so surprised, why don't you understand? That is not what he said. What did he say? told He said, 70 fools and slow of heart 10 not to believe what I 1/1/you not to remember what I explained to you when I was here among you. "Oh fools and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken, Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophete, he expoinded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself." What is the Old Testament, what is the scientific approach? to the Old Testament? The famous Laawrence of Arabia, a man who led the gerilla warfare in Wordd War I Later on hid himself in an English army camp against the Turks in Arabia, in India.
