ively and to come out with an all-millenial conclusion. I was talking with an allmillenialist one time and I quoted to him a verse in the book Jeremiah 31:34, The Lord says that a time is coming when of Jeremiah, they shall teach no more every man his neighbour and every man his broher saying, Know the Lord for they shall all know me a from the least of them unto the greatest of them saith the Lord for I will forgive their iniquity and I will remember their sin no more. Now I am not going at the present into/ to go/into the question, is this talking about all the world. Or is it just talking about the Jews or in the question, is it talking about all the world or is it talking about a certain section of the world? But I am going to ask this, regardless of that question, of the extent of it What is it saying, what is it taking about? It is not talking about heaven, it is absurd to say a thing like this about heaven. It is talking about something on this earth. Someone time on this earth. Now I talked to a good frliend of mine who took general all-melleniall views. And I said to him what does this passage mena? Well he says, that means that no one in the true church will say to another man in the true church, Know the Lord? because they all know the Lord. Well it seems to me that in that case, you ought to paraphrase and they shall teach no more his every man his neighbor and every man his brother saying, know the Lord, He took out everyone that knows the Lord from the least to the greatest of those that know the Lord shall know the Lord, (Laughter from audience) and therefore no one that knows the Lord shall say to another one that knows the Lord Know the Lord? (Laugher again (9)) Well, it is utterly absurbed. From any scientific approach to this passage ¥ you have to say, there is a time in an area and we are not $e \neq e \neq$ entering now into the question Is it the Jews, or is it all the nation, or is it an area or is it the whole but there **in** an area or a race which will completely every individaul in it know the Lord and there has no such time come as yet. in the church. And the only way it can come that I know of is either by the preaching of the Gospel universally the post-mellenial hope or by the Lord coming back
