Dear Dr. MacRae:

You will recall that tape recordings were made of your evening messages when you were here at Dallas Seminary last year. A person who was very interested in the subject of archaeology requested permission to transcribe these messages and offered to make a typewritten copy to be bound for our Library in exchange for the use of the tapes.

It developed that a defective machine was used for the recording of the first message and the tape was such that it could not be understood. The others were recorded on a different machine.
