

No human being could possibly have had that knowledge. Back of Ezekiel when he made this statement, there was an Intelligence surpassing human intelligence, there was a Knowledge there which no mere human being could have had. God Himself spoke through Ezekiel, as God Himself had spoken through Jeremich.

Now there are many other interesting instances, not quite as striking as these two although a number are nearly as striking, in the Old Testament. But as our clock is moving rapidly I am not going to call your attention to any one of them now, but instead will turn over to the New Testament, and in the New Testament I want to call your attention to an interesting statement in the Gospel of Luke, in the 21st chapter. There we read in vs. 24, chapter 21, of Luke's gospel, "And they shall fall by the edge of the sword and shall be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled". Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. When will the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled? We do not know, but they have not been yet, because ancient Jerusalem is today still trodden down of the Gentiles. I was over there last year, and of 36 important sites of ancient Jerusalem, 35 of them are today in Arab hands. I stood there in Arab Jerusalem a year ago today, and saw the little children running back and forth and playing, but they could only come this far because here was a barbed wire and beyond that barbed wire there was a solid block of ruined buildings and refuse and debris. At the other end of the block I could see the other line of wire and across there I could see the Jewish children playing. And if you want to go that one block from here to there, you have to take a plane and fly some hundreds of
