were to reach one person for Christ. Suppose that each day we were to spend time with this one discipling him, showing him how to grow in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord, teaching him to becomes a thoroughly mature Christian and that we were to keep this up for one year. Then at the end of that year suppose that the two of us were each to win one more person to Christ and to disciple him and train him and teach him the things of God for one year. At the end of two years there would then be four, a group of four earnest consecrated thourghly trained Christians. Let us suppose then that each of these four led four others to the -Lord and trained them in the things of Christ and then then at the end of the third year there would be eight, and at the end of the four year there would be 16. How long would it take before the entire 4 billion k- people on earth would have been thoroughly evangelized and trained to be earnest servants of Christ? In less than 33 years every individual on earth would have been won to Christ.

Of course this is not possible. It is not God's will that it should be done. But how far short of Hism will we have fallen when we think of the great numbers in , the thousand thousands in this country and the millions elsewhere who have never heard a clear picture of what Jesus did and how we can be saved. This wonderful statement about what Christ has done for us says, We are created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God prepared in advance for us to do.
