trouble if he doesn; t bring it to the surface, see what's wrong in it, bring it to the cross of Christ and get rid of it. If he can just do that and keep the Spirit searching ourhearts it's unlikely we will reach the point where we'll have to go to a human expert to try to bring the things to the surface that are giving us the trouble. But God knew this long before Freud ever dreamed of it and here it is in the Bible, the very foundation of MEMMEN modern psychology.

But people are so busy discussing things that don't particularlyy matter that they don't take the time to get in and get the exact words and get the ideas that are there and do == and see what tremendous importance they can have for our lives.

I don't know how much Paul knew about psychology. I know Paul had many erroneous ideas the same as every man living does, but God did not let those ideas get in here. And God may have given Paul the understanding of this particular point or he may simply have led him along to use words that would express it even though Paul did not fully understand it. But what we have here is God's Word. It is not dictated, but it is just as true as if it was dictated. If we want to know anything beyond the things we can taste and touch, beyond those there is one way to find it. Get a revelation from One who knows and the only One who knows - - -
