God in times past spoke in divers manners and sundry ways through the prophets. In these latter days He has spoken through a Son. God has spoken. God has communicated. It is one of the commonest facts of life. It would be strange if God did not speak. Here is what He has spoken. We can depend upon it, because it has come from Him. However, the fact of revelation is not merely one of the commonest facts of life, it is also one of the most baffling facts of life. Parents try to communicate their ideas to their children, and often find it difficult. You express things, they don't yet have the background to understand it. Part of the idea sinks in, you repeat it, you stress it, you give it again. Time after time you go over things. Eventually perhaps it remains. A friend told me once of going to Canada to preach in a church. He said that he felt that what the people needed more than anything else was an understanding of the freedom of God's grace.
