are destroying individuals, that are leading people into damnation. Christ said of them, Woe unto them, It were better that a milstone were tied abouthis neck and that he were cast into the depths of the sea! To have this perfect had red—the kind that has depths of feeling because of our determination to follow the Lord and do His will, but six that is directly wisely and sanely to advance the work of the Lord and to oppose all that which is toward conteary to His will, rather than blindly striking out and as a result usually accomplishing nothing.

May God give us the spirit of love we should have. May he keep us from the spirit of personal hatred which it is so easy for us to fall into. But may he give us that perfect hatred which both the OT and the NT speak of and an essential part of the attitude of the true believer who not only follows Christ and serves him but opposes all that would destroy the souls of men and would destroy the knowledge of Him.
