That is your standing before God, but if you are, then realize it in your mind and in your...10. .., seek those things which are above, where Christ sits on the right hand of God. So then, He wants us to realize this fact of our standing, that we are crucified with Christ, but He wants us also to see it become more and more a reality in our lives.
