You notice that in this chapter of Corinthians where Paul talks about the carnal Christian, he talked in Corinthians elsewhere about physical sensuous sin which had come into the church, and which must be rooted out, or at least ~~xxxx~~ must be strongly disciplined. He speaks about that elsewhere. But that's not where he uses this word and speaks about the carnal Christian. He says, Ye are ~~His~~ yet carnal, for whereas there is among you envying and strife, and ~~fixix~~ division, are ye not carnal and walk in sin? Should we have division? You can't read the Bible and say we shouldn't have division. Moses called, Who is on the Lord's side? Let them rally to me. There is a division in the world, there is a <sup>l</sup>division between those who stand for Christ, and those who stand against Him, and it is a division which should be as clear cut as we can possible make it. I don't say a division between those who are saved and those who are lost, but between those who are trying to advance the work of Christ, and those who are advancing neo-orthodoxy or modernism or ~~any~~ anything else which tends to lead souls in such a direction as to end in eternal ~~pe~~dition. There should be a sharp division between the true Christian who is advancing the cause of Christ, and the one who is tearing down the work of Christ, but among the true Christians Paul says the carnal one is the one who is saying, I am of Paul, I am of Apollos. He says, Are ye not ~~carnaal~~? Now, this is not the only thing ~~that~~ makes us carnal. But it is something that is so so easy to come into. I don't think of anything that has done as much harm in the church of Christ as ~~spiritual~~ spiritual pride. And when we find ourselves criticizing other Christians on minor matters, it is an evidence of spiritual pride. It is an evidence of carnality within ourselves. We have the task of growing into the true wheat ourselves. We have that task, and it is a big one, and may God help us to grow and ~~pe~~form the task that He wants usto. May God help us to stand adamant and four-square against that which is contrary to His will, that His church may be an instrument that speaks with a united voice for God's truth, and is used of Him. May He help us to sow the seed on every possible opportunity, and to spread the Word of Christ, that it may be used in leading
