And there as he was in the Temple he had a vision, some say Isaiah was transported to heaven (5 3/4)

and had this vision there, but this we know, that the one Isaiah saw was the Lord.

That is the first sight Isaiah saw. It is the sight that everyone must see whose life is to accomplish much for the Lord. It is a sight (6)
