Now in our day God does not often, if ever, speak directly to an individual in a way in which He spoke to Jonah.there. God leads us in many ways, but the principle way He speaks is very close to the way He spoke to Jonah, that is by the word of of the Lord. But the Word of the Lord was given to the prophets in ancient times and in New Testament times and is written in the this book and we have the message that He wanter us to have. And the spirit of God, as we study the Word applies it to our heatts and leads us and shows us the principles which should condition our life and our service for Him. And so in a way it is just the same. God spoke to Jonah and said to go to Nineveh and cry against it. In our day God speaks to everyone of us through the Wrod of God and mene tells us that there is a world that needs Christ and that it is our place to get the message to that world, to get the message to those who are nearer to us and
