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as Saviour. It is going to be tremendously important what you know of theology and Greek and Hebrew and Apologetics, and all these other things, but there is and her factor which is not the only factor, nor even the main factor, but which, if it is missing, you will accomplish very little. That is the factor of knowing how to get along with people. Knowing how to present the message in a way to win people instead of driving them away. I don't care whether the Lord leads you into preaching, whether Me leads you into teaching, whether He leads you to do missionary work, what He leads you into, it is going to be tremendously important to know how to say the right thing, and not to say the wrong thing in all kinds of situations.

Oh, Franklin D. Roosevelt was a man who had an ability to say terrible things to people and make them like it, he had a remarkable talent, he knew just how to win people, some of it I think went too far, there were things I didn't like at all about the way he did things, but some of us are so honest that we've got to antagonize everybody, for fear we might give them a misunderstanding about what we think.

The book of Matthew comes to the Jews and he says Jesus Christ is the King, He is the one who saves you from the hated Romans and to rule over you. Mark was written in the first instance not for the Jews but for the Romans who were the king's, and Mark doesn't start in and tell us about the king at all, he tells about Jesus as the servant, the burden-bearer, the one who can satisfy their need, and then when they come to know Christ, they learn Ne is the king and they accept Him in that phase also, but he starts in with that which will win them instead of starting with that which will drive them away. And living in a community like this, with a group of people this size, you are going to be rubbing shoulders with other people, and they there are going to be all kinds of little irritations, there are bound to be, and those little irritations give you an opportunity to learn how to win people, amd make people take things from you and be pleased with it, rather than to irritate them and to drive them away, and it is one of the greatest opportunities that God ever gives a person, is to be with others to

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
