SOME DATES LEADING TOWARD FORMATION OF THE NCC

- 1894 - CONFERENCE AT UNION THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY, NY, CALLED FOR COMM. TO CONSIDER PRACTICABILITY OF ORGAN. FEDERATE COUNCIL OF CHURCHES IN NYCITY.
- 1900 - FEDERATE COUNCIL OF CHURCHES IN NYC CALLED FOR RESOLUTION TO FORM NAT'L FEDERATION OF CHURCHES; APPT. COMM. OF 25.
- 1901 - NATIONAL FEDERATION OF CHURCHES ORGANIZED IN PHILADELPHIA; HARRY F. WARD HELPED.
- 1902 - 2ND CONFERENCE OF NAT'L FEDERATION OF CHURCHES HELD IN WASH. D.C.; PRES. ROOSEVELT REFUSE TO ATTEND.
- 1905 - INTER-CHURCH CONF. ON FEDERATION HELD IN NYC - MADE FORMAL PROPOSAL TO FORM FEDERAL COUNCIL OF CHURCHES.
- 1908 - FEDERAL COUNCIL OF CHURCHES OFFICIALLY FORMED, NYC. BISHOP E.R. HENDRICKS, KANSAS CITY - METHODIST - 1ST PRESIDENT
- 1950 - FEDERAL COUNCIL BECAME THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF CHURCHES
