you'll have the blessing that every Christian ought to have. Get the last four chapters so you'll have the many blessings every Christian ought to have in them. And then go through these chapters in the middle and see what there is that you can get without becoming **dd**gmatic about things on which others will differ. And in the course of time, you will find more and more on which you can stand, (6) in which you can be blessed, for it is a book which is full of great blessing for us, a book which should be very vital in our lives, but this morning I've tried to know a few of these which should be important to us, There is going to be this unveiling, the Lord is going to bring the age to an end. When? Maybe very soon, we don't know. Maybe it's quite a ways off, we don't know, but let us live as if it was right now.

What if Jesus should come this afternoon, are you ready for Him? Oh, you say, if I knew Jesus was coming this afternoon, I'd spend this morning out here trying to talk to people about the Lord so they would accept Him, so they would believe on Him. Well you shouldn't do that because you should be in class, but there are hours when you aren't in class when you can be doing that. Suppose He came this afternoon and you said, O Lord, I would have been out telling everybody about you if I'd known you were coming this afternoon. He'd say, what did you do last Saturday? What about that? You say, I was in class, what good does this do, to what I learned in class, now you're here? Well, He'd say, you don't know when I'm coming, I want you to prepare as if you had fifty years service ahead of you, but I want you to be ready as if I might come the next minute, so that when He comes, if you've been faithfully preparing to make your life count to the utmost, and serving Him as well as you can while you're doing it, He will say, well done, good and faithful servant, just as much as if you had finished if fifty years of active service.
