Is Jesus Christ at the very center of our lives? Is His coming something that is real to you, so real that it affects what you do today? That it affects what your plans are for tomorrow? Are you so living, that if He comes next week, or next month, or next year, He will say, well done, good and faithful servant, you made your time count for me, you were preparing and you were serving me along with it, all you could, but you were preparing that your life would count in great service in days to come. Are we studying these chapters about the churches, and in our relationship with others , seeing the (9 1/4)here and the blessing and seeing the things He wans us against and avoiding them. Oh, there is something for all of us in the book of Revelation. May God help us to get the blessing from this book and the other books, that our lives may count to the utmost. Let us pray: O God our Father, we thank You for this wonderful Bible, and we thank You for this book with which it ends, O we thank You for the blessings in this book, we thank You, O our God, for what it can mean to us. O there is a bleesing on those that read and on those that hear and on those that do what is in it. Help us never to just hear the Word but to be doers also. Help us
