The Servant of the Lord is blind, we are told in verse 19. w While in verse 2 we h are told that he shall not ... nor lift up his voice to be heard in the streets. He shall bring forth judgment into the earth. You just can't possibly do it. And the certainty that God is going to do it. And so you have here the this verse about the Servant in verse 19, and in 20 seeing many things but thou observest not. Ears open but hearest not. The Lord is well pel- pleased for His righteousness sake. He will magnifi the Law and make it honorable. This one, when you get to 21, one of Isal- Isaiah's ... what are ... you say the Lord is going to magnify the Law and make it honorable . You say the Servant is going to bring judgment to the Gentiles. Look at their condition in exile. But he says this is a people robbed and spoiled. You say that they are going to over-... you say they are going to bring out the .. then are in exile. They are in misery --and Isa. answers in-Isa. verse 24. Who gave Jacob for a spoil. Who has gave us this situation. Did not the Lord against whom we have sinned, kex for they would not walk in His ways, nie- neither would they obedient unto His law. Therefore hath he brought upon him - them the fury of His anger and have set them on fire a round about. If you are
