static explaining to them what it meant, and training the sons of the prophets, weaning them away from their superstitios ideas, get the true understanding of God's word and His ways, so that the work was accomplished through the possibly life of the two men in a way of them could/have done it by himself. /Elijah only had been there, there would have been this great thing that everybody in the land knew about it, and was tremendously interested, but isn't it marvellous? The proof has come that Jehovah, not Baal, is the true God. And then they would have forgotten about it and would have gradually sunk into back to their minds, gradually Jezebel would have won them over the leaders, and more and more of them / to Baal worship. And Baal worship would have become eventually supreme and eventually there would be people there who would say, Well, we heard for some marvellous things that happened some years ago. Somebody told me that he was there, and he saw him, but now he is dead of now. And I think that any evidence of people believing can hardly be true, because you do not see people believe that way now. looking at all these people who are prominent in the land, They are worshipping We had better go into that direction. Elijah's work would have made a tremendous flash, and disappeared, if had not been followed by the work of Elisha. On the other hand, if Elisha alone had come without Elijah, he would have wone a few people here and there, and he would have a good solid work, the solid work that will last, perhaps, for somegenerations, but that would have affected comparatively a few people. It hink that we can assume and safely say that Elisha with Elijah's work preceding him affected a hundred times as many people, perhaps a thousandx times as many as Elisha could possibly won himself without Elijah preceding, and Elijah's work would have had a tremendous impact for a brief time, and then was completely gone if it were
