But perhaps the next day some one else will just speak to them and they will, and perhaps all the work that you have done has been preparing for it, and really having a tremendous lot to do with the result. You can't tell who is going to be saved, ke so it is not God's function to us to win them to Christ, but it is God's fundtion function for us to introduce people to bring them to an awareness of Him, to an awareness of their sin, to an awareness of who is-He is and what He has done, and what He desires to do. It is His will that we shold-should introduce them to x Christ, Somebody has said, God is not looking for lawyeres, but for witneses, now k that is half true, there is a need , but k it is true that there is a far greatter greater need of witnessing, and the witness of what & Christ means to you, and what He has meant in your life, and the witness of your joy and happiness
