I said, I feel they are going to call on me real soon and I'd like to do some very careful thinking. Sp he and I mushed down tothe hotel, got a quick sandwieh and I satd to hin, You't think from the way they are talking that all scholers believed this ligher criticism; we got to have some names of scholars who hold as we do. Would you mind weiting out mifebinames for me. It's not so dasy for the queselon, the answers. You might be able to give any number with pleaty of time, so he wrote out a list for me. They were just hefter-skelter as he happened to think of thiem and he wrote them, on a plece of paper, We talked over different things they migtit ask. We went back, for the afternem session of the trial. It came in the middle of the afternoon. Dr: Fowlerts depostition was finished and then they called on me as a witness. Our lawyer immediately asked, me abouk my educatton, where i hau studied, where I had taught, etc. He asked me $1 f$ I had looked ovẹ Fowlen's book and if $I$ thought 1 t. was relfgious Anstruction. I told him yes, it was the presentation ofr religion, d different religion from the Christian religion. The Christian religion teaches that God spoke to mañ, God didgreat things in the world, But, I said, there tis a different religions apprasich which says that man has been groping after truth, and the Bbole according to this is just a record of man's gropings. I said.that-is a. rellgious instructoon, - different kind of religious instruction and it should not be teught under" the terms of the vi of wathington's constitutton. If the Christian religion is not to pe taught as the supreme Court has declared, somn wixx well then certainly an anti-chisistian religion should not be taught.

Now' right there later, I wished that I had had more time zo prepare because I would not have used that word g groping. I think it's a good word, hut it's a word that can lead to misunderstanding. I said the Bible 1 s the cecord of God speakin'g to man; God's dealings with man. This other:religion says the bible is a record of man's groping after truth. Later on the lawyer sajd, You folks are, the bellevers and we're the gropers. They kept coming back to that, you see. It wasn!t. what I"d saldat aly. I sald that that religion teaches that the men who wrotes the Bible were groping after triuth. And itts exactly what-1t does. It is what is being taught in many of the requised courses in many of our institutions today and in many courses in great many booke. I wish I had had time to think of better word thit hould not have 1 end $==1$ ent itself to mizunderstanding as they put into the paper and as they used in that way.

Then I wish someone had given me a 11 tele instructoon in trial decorum. Never before in my 1 fifehad I been a witness at a trial. I had spent my life in the elassraom, iecturlng the students, trying to get truth aeross to situdents, trying to advance their understanding, trying to be of any help I can in ary situation. That was the way my whole life had been spent before the trial how I wish I had the versitility of a man like Dr. Mcintire. When Dr. McIntire was called as aitness he was so different from dnytime I'd ever seen him. He lu'st fit right exactly into that pattern. He was asked the questions and he answared them In sumy a way as ift Whit; I just want ta give you these facts so the Judige car have them. It was very very effective.
