

that desires to have an effect upon the world in connection with religion, and he went to a school where he was taught that the Bible was full of errors and he gave up his faith in the Bible.

Prof. Killie who died a number of yrs. ago was one of the great influences in religion in recent years. A professor in Union Seminary for 20 yrs. A university prof. at Harvard for some years. Then prof. in the U. of Chicago. He was one that so many of our conservatives said, O we must study Killie and see what is his viewpoint. (The name is Tillich not Killie)

Tillich who died two years ago was one who had a tremendous influence in destroying people's faith. He spoke in many of our universities all over the country and he was welcomed in large churches all over the country. I attended a seminary at the U. of PA. at which Tillich answered questions for a long time on many different subjects. In answer to one of those questions I was most interested to hear Prof. Tillich say this: You cannot imagine the anguish and the misery that I experience for a period of time coming as I did from the home of a very orthodox country pastor, my father, where I had been brought up. When I got into the University and found I could no longer believe that the Bible is entirely true.

I don't think most people who heard Tillich speak ever realized that important turning point in his life, but he certainly brought it out clearly there. He showed that it was that evangelical background in that godly home that gave Tillich the energy and enthusiasm and desire to make religion a greater force in life. But it was that indoctrination in the University leading him to believe that the Bible is not true and dependable that shifted him onto another. And most of the leaders in the WCC and in the NCC that are effective, the men who are out to turn society upside down and change things all around, they are putting into that the enthusiasm and an emotion that has been shifted and diverted away from that which gave it to them in the first place, and it is the result of their having been indoctrinated in unbelief in the Word of God.

Well now, it is a very strange thing indeed that during these last 60 years when unbelief has been increased geometrically and spread more widely in every way and people are getting more dogmatic in their attacks upon the Word of God, that during this very period evidences in relation to the Bible had been coming to light to answer the attacks and questions against the Word of God. So that today we are in a far better position to defend the Word of God than we ever were before.

Now I think one thing in defending the Bible is always to look at it closely. I have found that time and again somebody comes to me asking, What do you do with this contradiction in the Bible? How can you accept the Bible when it says this? Well, I say, let's look at the verse. We look at the verses and half of the problems disappear when you look closely at what's there. About half of the remainder are put into it
