6. That Marvellous Deliverance at the Red Ses. Ch. 14. When the Lord allows Red the poeple to get into a position where the wilderness shuts them in and the #7/##f-Sea #### is right before them and there seems to be absolutely no way of deliverance and then the Lord intervenes in such a marvellous way. We are all of course wery familiar with the story of How He led them through the Red Sea; how He so marvellously delivered We will not look into details of it. It is background for Num. rather than as yet, but it is an evidence of the fact that there will be even in th early part of the Christian life situations in which if we truly keep our y eyes on Him He will work things in ways we would never dream of and accomplish His purpose and deliverance.

But let's not forget No. 7 - Ch. 15 the song of praise for deliverance. How meady we are to look to the Lord for help and then how often we fail to thank Him for hhe help that He has given. Here we have the children of Israèl singing this wonderful great song of praise to the Lord for what He has done. and Miriam leading them in this/praise to God for what He has done. O the marvellous deliverance the Lord brings in the lives of each of us if we truly wait upon Him. But let us not forget to stop and thank Him for it and to remember what he does in our lives. I think we will stop at this point. Let us close with prayer. Our Father we thank you for this background for the book of Num. We thank you for the experience the Israelites had right in the first year of their wilderness journey. Preparing them for the long/######
