We cannot get victory over the power of sin except as we avail ourselves of the power of Christ. But yet we are ordered to strive. These people are here rebuked. "Ye have not yet resisted unto blood striving against sin." We are in a pilgrim journey, and we must push forward with all our might <sup>seeking</sup> /to attain
