to be successful unless God is giving the victory. And so God wanted an illustration below of this in this remarkable way that is given in this g case. Where Moses up his hands; when he holds up his hands they win, but it gets pretty tiresome all day holding your hands up there. And Moses f at this time was about 100 years old.

as you know. It would be pretty tiresome for a young fellow like me to do that.

(Laughter), but for Moses you can imagine it would get pretty tiresome. And so we read here that Aaron and Hur lifted up his hands. The illustration is given here that God may appoint a leader to do, to intercede with Him, a leader to represent Him in a situation but that God does not work through one man. God always has their associates and assistants who use their brains, who use their physical strenthe to help this man.

And then look at vs. 14. And if this was all that you had about this, just vs. 14, what would you say happened after this? The "And the Lord said unto Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and rehearse it in the ears of Hoshua
