I have heard people say, people of the world wouldn't act the way those Christians do. Well, alas that is all too often true because we are all sinners. We all fall far short of the glory of God. But only God can see the heart and God knows who the true Christians are and as we go up how interesting it will be to look about and see some of those with us that we did not realize were truly believers in Christ and truly were growing in grace all the time, even though they like ourselves have a long distance yet to go.
