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We are not told we can go out and/win the whole world for Christ. That is a disappointment to many people. They xex I read an article by a very fine Christian scholar who said, I don't believe the Holy Spirit is so weak that he can't win the whole world to Christ. Well I don't either; I believe the Holy Spirit could this minute make everyone in the world Christian if that was God's will, but God has not chosen to move in that way. God has chosen to move in a different way. I mentioned yesterday how if one of us were to lead another one to Christ and the next year the 2 of us lead 2 more and so one, in 31 years every man, woman and child could be Christian and yet 1900 years, nearly 2,000 years have gone by and there are more non-Christians in the world today than there are Christians.

What I mentioned yesterday was only what would be theoretically possible. Actually it is not God's will that all the world be won. There has never been a whole country won. There has never been a whole city won. I doubt that there has ever been a whole family that has gone on for as much as 2 or 3 generations with everyone in it being truly saved. He desires to cleanse us from it and then we cannot overlook the fact that in the world there is a wicked power. There is the power of satan.
