He stresses ~~he+he+~~ here the fact that for every one of us, of supreme importance in our lives is the question whether we are growing in the knowledge of the Lord. Why does God put us here? Why do we stay here on this ~~earth~~ ^{earth} ~~earth~~?

I heard a man say once, I wonder why doesn't God take us to heaven as soon as we are saved? As soon as we believe in Christ, why doesn't He take us right to heaven? Well, he said, the answer is we stay here in order to spread the knowledge of Christ to others, to tell them how they can be saved.
