to this man, You are wicked to stay in this denomination, in which the modernists are more and more gaining control. He went to him, talked to him, learned something of his viewpoint and saw his desire to serve God and gave him ammunition to stand for God and to present the Word of God truly. He became friends of this man, and this man introduced him to members of his church and they were godly members in a godly church. Francis tried to get the man to lead his people out of this denomination, but he would not do it, and he got called to a larger church where he said I can serve the Lord greater in this place in another state. He left this place, and then the denominational organization brought into the church a man with a pleasant personality but no belief whatever. Francis said when that happened, I went out and visited the members of the church and showed them what was happening, and presented them evidence and he said half of them of the members of that church left it and came over and joined my church. He said in that church they had a picture in the hall of their great missionaries who had spent many years in Asia but who had now retired and was living there and was an active member of the church. And he came over to Francis' church. Francis said, They've got the picture but we've got the missionary.

The way to take a stand on matters both of which are true is not by taking a position in the middle. It's by standing for both of them, by getting a proper balance. I used to give an illustration. Somebody has questioned it, but I still think it's a good work one. I take a pail full of water and I try to carry it in one hand and it is quite difficult. But I
