Somebody misquites slightly and then you are quoted as having said something about some particular organization that is not true. So I like to refer in general terms, but to facts with which I have contact.

I might mention our library as one illustration. The library we are very fortunate to have the library we do here at ~~Faith Seminary~~ ~~at~~ BST± it is the library that another institution gathered over a period of about 50 years. They selected the books they felt would be useful and they encouraged the students at that time. Now there were some things in that institution, some emphases that I don't altogether agree with in those years. I think there were seeds of weakness in the institution right from the time of its founding. But there was in it a central emphasis upon learning what the Bible says and learning to present it. That institution through the course of the years trained 3000 Christian workers, men and women.
