What the results may be at in feel years if our Lord tarries I am not in a position to judge, but in the immediate situation I know that they have every reason to be thankful and for what you did.

In the case of the Nazarene Church/at-which you have been speaking the sitat-situation is a little different because we do not have the same responsibility the toward them that we have toward the fruits of the work of the Independent Board. If they invite you to come, ask-yeu- and to conduct these services, I would feel that the responsibility was on their hands, rather than in any way on ours or on yours. I would think it however very wise to be sure that it is understood to be strictly on a temporary basis and as a maa matter of specific invitation for each that time.
