A sizeable group of converts was won to Christ. After a time however, he felt that he must be able to speak more publicly. It was unsatisfactory having to do everything thus in secret. He managed to get away and go back to Europe in order to gather recruits and attempt another, to try to forward the training of others for Mohammedan missions, and to make another attempt to preach in Tunisia.
