at the time but in the sight of God, who demands absolute truthfulness, an untruth is sufficient to deny one entrance into His Kingdom.

It is sad that in these times people are not apt to realise the greatness of God and how much He demands. It would be good for all of us to read carefully and thoughtfully the ten commandments or the sermon on the mount. To think solemnly of the tremendous demands that they make upon us. Which of us can fulfil these demands?

Which of us is clean enough to enter into the courts of the Lord?

Jesus said: (Matth. 5: 29 - 30)

"If thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish and not that thy whole body shall be cast into hell." "And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee, for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell."

(Matth. 5: 21 - 23)

"Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time,
Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill be in danger
of the judgment. But I say unto you, That whosoever
is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in
danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his
brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but
