When you have 10,000 people and identify it as "that rogue corporation" he was just reflecting the propaganda so widespread today. That is Humphrey and others are urging that we throw away fiscal stability in order to give a job to everybody. What that means is that soon everybody will bexam working for the government. Soun we will be like India or China.

I don't look for a continuation of telephones, and of gas stations on every corner, different companies where you culd shop around for the best bargain you could get. I look for that you will have to hunt to find any gasoline! I look for a going back because we are the system that has made our nation great. Whatever may come we don't need to worry (

But if the Lord does not and we === He told us we don't know when he's coming. We definitely have no right to say he won't come, but we have no right to say that he must come within the next few years. We don't know when he is coming and if the Lord does not come soon, present conditions, present attitudes mean that that upon which our system has been built - the so called capitalist system - the general Christian character of it and unless these we will be like the people of China or India.

I saw a statement not long ago dividing the world into the first world - the U.S. and a few countries of Europe; the second world; the third world; the fourth world. And they told how many people were in each. And it was interesting to see that half the people of the world today have less than \$200 a year to live on -- half the people of the world! It's hard for us to believe. But those are the figures. And of the remaining half, at least half would not come any where near \$1000 a year. It is a situation that is difficult for us to comprehend.

The greatest thing we can do for these people by far is to give them the Gospel. But when the communists

I saw a magazine with great big heading on it "Hunger is an obscene word". What is sounded like is that we in America

should divide it up. INX Fine. But would any of us have anything thing?

The way to do it is to bring them the knowledge of the Gospel, to develop Christian character among them, and to bring them a system of freedom not a system of tyranny not as is being established little by little in our country today. We have gone a long long way in that direction.

We don't discuss this a great deal today. The people on the other side are constantly discussing it. They are getting peoples minds and they are affected by it more than we know it. Now often when I hear anybody say anything against our system they will say it is communism; that's the communists. Well I believe the communists are doing everything they can to destroy our system, but I don't think they are that powerful. I think that 9/10th, perhaps 95% of the progress -- progress in the wrong direction -- that is made today is not the result of efforts made by communists, or by people
