so long as you do what the rulers tell you. And so long as you don't disobey what the rulers two years from now are apt to tell you then. Everything is orderly, and you're under complete discipline. But how miserable!

Think of the freedom we have in this country! Russia is in a way in between the two. You don't have as much order as in China, you don't have quite as much slavery as in China but you have got much of the same situation. There's more than a third of the people of the world suffering in these situations. And we in America, think how we are blessed! Wouldn't you think everyone in America would be happy when you compare our situation with that of people in most other parts of the world? Shouldn't be all be rejoicing?

You go down to the Mexican border where thousands are thying to get into this country to enjoy some of the blessings we have here. And some of the people we have here who claim to be great humanitarians, are demanding that we use force to keep those people out so that they can't share it all -- all the good things we have here. I remember 40 years ago, one time when I landed in this country on a boat there was a young fellow from Nowway on the boat who had gotten a visa to come to the United States. He had to go through all kinds of problems to get the visa and now he had it. He told me, Oh, I hope there is no slip up. I hope I can get in alright. Then he came and went to the immigration officers. His face was just beaming. He said, I got into the country. Well with all the trouble they'd put bim through before there should not have been any problem, but after all the difficulties he'd had before he did not know what difficulties he might face. America is way ahead in material things of every part of the world. You go to Europe and you pay \$1 to \$1.50 for a gallon of gasoline.
