And may we not in our responses go beyond what it it says, but we thank you our Father that whether it be your will that a great stand be made to accomplish much against the forces of unbelief, or whether it be your will that this like so many others will not accomplish much, that you will accomplish much through prayer, our Father, and in response to to the prayers of your people it is your will to accomplish in the world. So we pray that in these days when much is made of the use of Biblical languages but when so much in the world is turning against it, turning against your teachings, cause us our Father that there may be an increasing witness to the great truths of your Word, and an increasing trust in our sovereign God.
